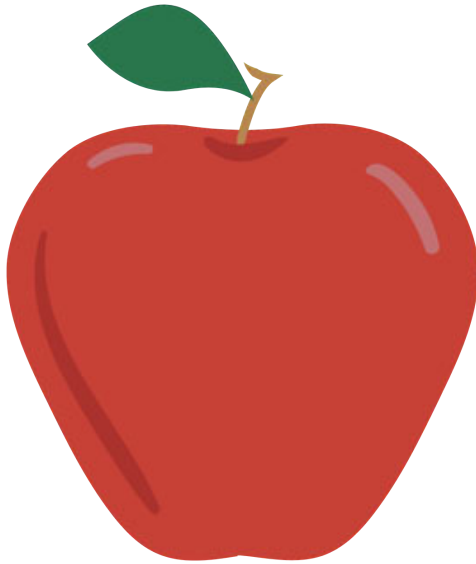

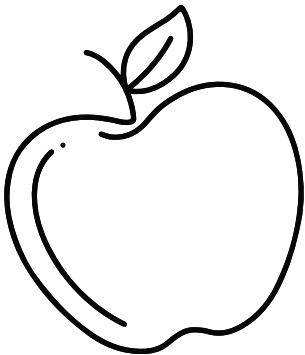

I have always wanted to direct this play, ever since I first saw it at Ball State. *All I Really Need to Know I Learned in Kindergarten* is what is known as a "vignette" play, a series of short, independent stories that are all connected by a common theme. 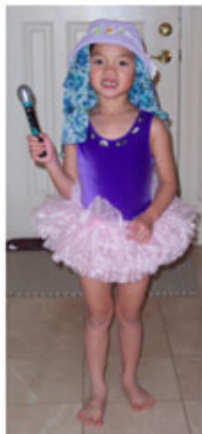

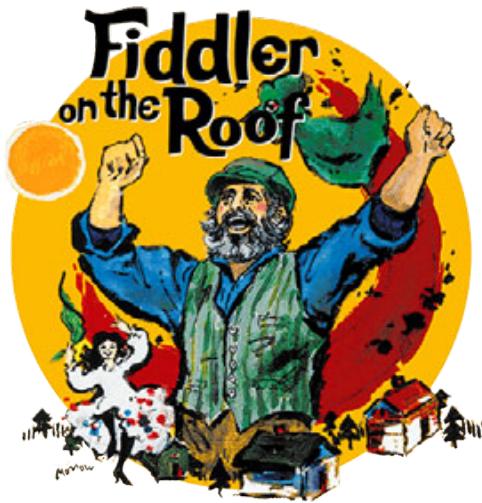
