You are also welcome to also email Mrs. Helfrich to let her know of any new applications just to ensure she knows to send your documents to your schools.

Final Transcript Send

I automatically send your final transcript to the school you indicate you are enrolling in in Scoir once grades are finalized in May. Be sure Scoir is updated with all of your admission decisions (including waitlisted schools!) and your choice of enrollment so your final transcript gets sent to the correct places.

College Athletes

If you are playing a Division I or II sport, you need to request your final amateurism certificate. <u>Here is more information</u>.

Enrollment

Remember, you need to put a deposit down at whatever school you decide you want to go to in order to hold your spot. You need to actually tell your college you are going there and pay the enrollment fee. You will likely do this through your college application portal!!

May 1st is college decision day, if you are hoping to get into a school you are waitlisted at, you will still need to put a deposit down at a place where you were fully admitted before May 1. If you are accepted off of the waitlist, you will unenroll at the school you put a deposit down at and enroll at the school you got off the waitlist for.

You also need to tell me where you are enrolling in Scoir! This is what we will use for graduation materials.
