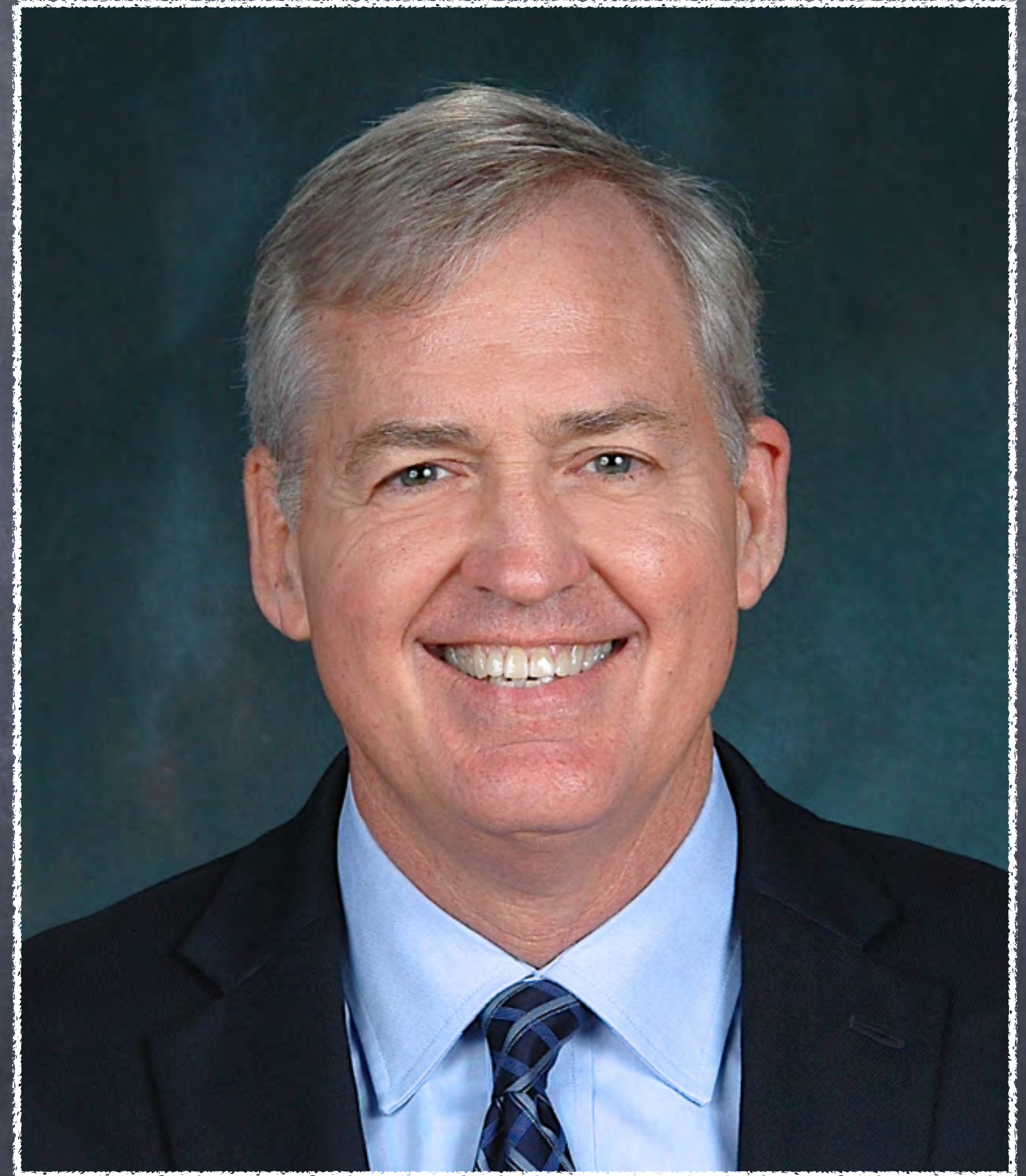

Feeding the Future with Healthy School Lunches

The National School Lunch Program (NSLP) is a federally assisted meal program operating in public and nonprofit private schools and residential child care institutions. It provides nutritionally balanced, low-cost or free lunches to children each school day. The program was established under the National School Lunch Act, signed by President Harry Truman in 1946.

What's the deal with the "Meal Deal"?



- Meal pattern from USDA standards that students must select in order to receive a reimbursable (free) meal.
- Lunch select minimum 3 out of 5 food groups
- Chatard Meal Deal Costs \$3.75 & includes any entree or sandwich, up to 2 veggies and fruits, and milk
- Breakfast select 3 out of 4 food groups
- "Extra items and "Non-Program Foods" are sold as Ala Carte and not included in the "meal deal"



No Meal Deal! \$2.55
 Partial Entrée (Chicken) \$2.00
 Milk \$0.55



No Meal Deal! \$3.30
 Full Entrée (Chicken and Roll) \$2.00
 Milk \$0.55
 Side (Roll) \$0.75



Meal Deal! \$3.00
 Full Entrée, 1 Vegetable Side, Milk



Meal Deal! \$3.00
 Full Entrée, 2 Vegetable Sides, 2 Fruit Sides, Milk



School Year 2022-2023

- USDA Free Meal Waiver ended June 1, 2002. Families must once again apply for eligibility.
- Family's will need to complete the free/reduced lunch application if they wish to be eligible for text book assistance.

Apply online through MyMealTime.com

1. Go to MyMealTime.com, Free Reduced Lunch Application



2. If you already have a MyMealtime account, log-in and click on Free & Reduced Applications.
3. If you do not have a MyMealtime account, you will need to create one by clicking on 'Create New Profile.'
4. Complete the application as directed.

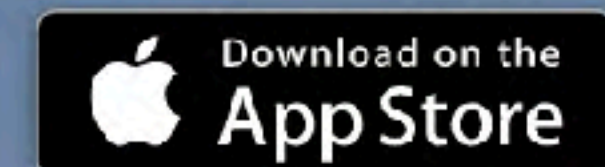
