Core 40 with Academic Honors Diploma

In addition to earning the requirements for the Core 40 Diploma, students must complete the following:

- 2 fine arts credits
- World Language: Three (3) years of one language OR two (2) years of two different languages
- GPA of a 3.0 or better
- C- or better in every course counting towards the diploma
- One of the following:
 - 2 AP courses and the corresponding AP Exams
 - 2 Dual Credit courses
 - 1 AP course and the corresponding exam and 1 Dual Credit course
 - 55 credits
