Safety Protocol for Bishop Chatard July 2020 Music Camp

- 1) Please use Door #4 (which faces Crittenden Ave, on the south end of the main building) for entering and exiting school.
- 2) Upon entering the school, please wear a mask at ALL times. We will discuss the practical donning of masks when we open rehearsal. Wind players will need to remove their masks to play. Singers will keep masks on while singing.
- 3) Please maintain a safe distance from your classmates the best you can.
- 4) Hand sanitizer will be available. Please take advantage often! You may also bring your own personal hand sanitizer.
- 5) Mr. Duray will be at the main doors of the music room (115, lower level or what is considered the first floor) to let each of you in the room, one by one.
- 5a) BAND MEMBERS, before entering the room, you will assemble your instrument for use (if applicable). Upon entering the music room, please find an appropriate sized band locker for your instrument case and place it inside. You will be directed to your seat.
- 5b) CHOIR MEMBERS, you will be directed to your seat one-by-one.
- 6) Mr. Duray will distribute all materials one by one to each musician.
- 7) We will be exclusively using the restrooms on the first floor (lower level). Only 2 musicians may use the restroom at a time. Simply let me know you need the restroom and exit the music room door closest to you. Though the setup in the room provides more space than the setup in the past. However, to maintain safe distance, it may be required for those in your path to give you space.
- 8) I suggest bringing your own water bottle to rehearsal.
- 9) Before the end of each rehearsal, we will clean our chairs and stands with disinfectant wipes, which will be provided.
- 10) At the end of each rehearsal, I will dismiss each musician one by one. Instrumentalists will put their instrument in its case, place it in their music locker, and exit the room. Singers may exit the room immediately.

Daily Self-Check
