Sketchnotes are exactly what they sound like, sketches of your information. You are to sketch the ideas from your article. You may use words, but do your best to create images that reflect the information. Most of us are visual learners, and we learn from being able to visualize the information. Be creative.

How to draw **SKETCHNOTES**

Sketchnotes are NOT comics or illustrated text. They are visual guides. Follow these steps to get started.
