Welcome to the BCHS Class of 2030!

Enclosed is information that will help you learn about the classes you will be taking next year. The freshman course selection sheet and course descriptions packet have information about the courses you are required to take and those that are optional. Please look over this information to help you make preliminary decisions about the courses you'd like to take. During your course selection meeting, we will answer questions and ensure you are placed in the appropriate classes.

You may have heard that the Indiana Department of Education recently issued new diploma requirements beginning with the Class of 2029. We will discuss how these updates impact the Class of 2030 at the New Parent meeting in June 2026.

We have 7 periods at Bishop Chatard. Freshman students have five required subjects, leaving space for you to choose how to complete your child's personal schedule. The required freshman subjects are:

- Theology I (2 semesters)
- Physical Education & Health (2 semesters)
- English (2 semesters)
- Math (2 semesters)
- Science (2 semesters)

English, Math and Science are offered at various levels because everyone learns at a different pace. Your placement test results and recommendations from your current teachers will help us determine the right level for you. We will have all this information available during the course selection meeting.
