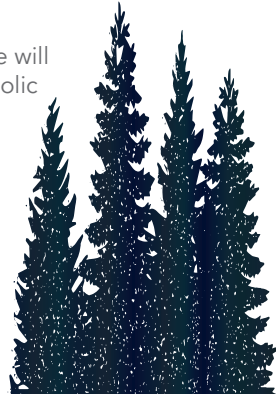

- On your TV:

 - Option 2:** Some Smart TVs have an Internet Browser you can type your personal link. You can find this link in the text from Qtego you received after registering.
 - Option 3:** Share the device logged into the live stream with an Apple TV.

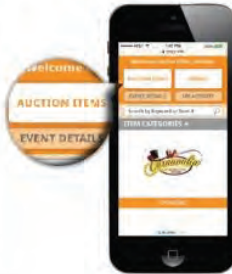
